この問題のすばらしい点は、まず今回のお題であった「比較級」を使う場面設定です。実に自然な文脈の中でありながら、比較の英文を理解しなければ正答を導き出せない設定になっていることが分かります。つまり、問解く上で、比較級の英文の理解が決定的な情報を握っています。

多くのみなさんが、コミュニケーションの場面や自然な状況設定を心がけていることが分かりました。それはもちろん素晴らしいことなのですが、中にはこれは比較表現を使った文が1文しかなかったり、比較の文を聞き取れなくても解答できちゃうのでは？という問題もありました。

そして、授業でお話した聞き返しや単語のみの発話など「話し言葉」と「書き言葉」の違いを捉えたスクリプトです。

全体的に、まだ「書き言葉を読んでいるようなスクリプト」が多くみられました。話し言葉と書き言葉の違いをもう一度確認の上、自分のスクリプトがいかに話し言葉らしいかを見返してみてください。

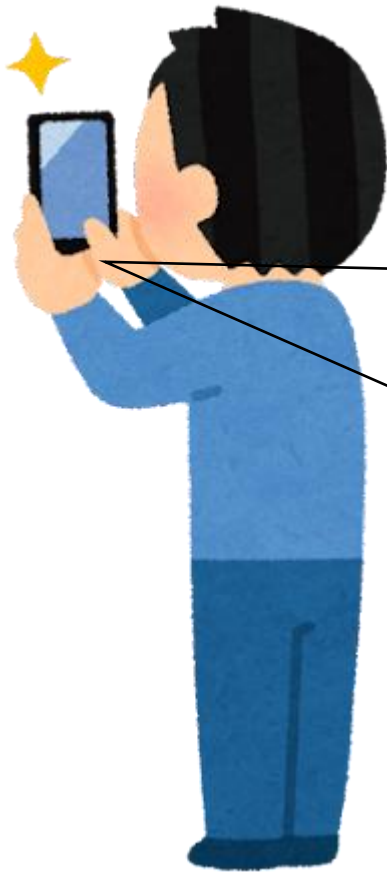
